



The Jersey Shore Area Joint Water Authority conducts annual hydrant flushing and testing to ensure that the water lines are fully functional for the purposes of private use, fire protection, and other services.

JSAJWA will be conducting systemwide hydrant flushing and testing beginning on **Monday April 21, 2025, and ending on Thursday May 1, 2025.** The days and hours are **Monday-Thursday 8am -4pm.**

What can be done to prepare for flushing?

Most customers do not notice anything as a result of flushing. However, if you are concerned, we encourage all customers to note the dates and times when our team will be flushing. While our team works through the system, you may consider the following ways to minimize the impact on your daily activities:



- **Run water in your tub or shower for 2 minutes before using water.**
- **Draw water for cooking ahead of time.**
- **Store a large bottle of water in the refrierator for drinking.**
- **Check for discolored water before using the washing machine or dishwasher.**

Areas involved will be Salladasburg Borough, Mifflin Township, Piatt Township, Antes Fort, Jersey Shore Borough, Porter Township, and South Avis.
