

RESOLUTION - 06-052026

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE JERSEY SHORE AREA
JOINT WATER AUTHORITY AMENDING ITS RULES AND REGULATIONS.**

WHEREAS, Jersey Shore Area Joint Water Authority (hereinafter "Authority") is a duly organized Pennsylvania Municipal Authority, pursuant to the provisions of the Pennsylvania Municipal Authority's Act, current codified at 53 PA.C.S.A § 5601 et., seq., (hereinafter "Act");

WHEREAS, the Jersey Shore Area Joint Water Authority has adopted Rules and Regulations pursuant to section 5607(d) of the Act, or its predecessor, related to the operation and maintenance of Authority's Water Treatment and Distribution System; and

WHEREAS, the Authority is desirous of amending its Rules and Regulations in accordance with the terms herein.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED and IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Jersey Shore Area Joint Water Authority that the Rules and Regulations of the Authority are amended as follows:

SECTION 1:

Section VII subsection C is deleted and replaced with the following language:

"C. If water and sewer invoices are not paid within thirty (30) days from the date of billing, the Authority will add to the bill a ten (10%) percent late penalty charge."

SECTION 2.

Section VII, subsection K, is deleted and replaced with the following language:

"K. Payment may be made by check, certified check, cashier's check or money order without additional fees. Payments by credit or debit card are subject to an additional fee at the current processing fee rates in addition to the billed charges. ACH is available on the Authority's website, subject to additional fee at current processing

fee rates in addition to the billed charges. Payment may also be made at approved third party business locations subject to any fees charged by the third party business.

SECTION 3.

Section X is amended to add the following subsection "C" which shall read as follows:

"C. Barring any unforeseen circumstances, water service shall be reinstated within 24 hours of payment of the restoration fee in the amount set forth by the Authority from time to time. Restoration fees will only be accepted by cashier's check, certified check, or money order."

SECTION 4.

In all other respects the Rules and Regulations of the Authority shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5.

This Resolution shall replace and supersede any other resolutions of the Authority with respect to the subject matter contained herein. To the extent that they are not inconsistent herewith.

SECTION 6.

The provisions of this Resolution are severable. If any sentence, clause, or section of this Resolution is for any reason found to unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionally, illegality or invalidity shall not effect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses or sections it being the Authority's intention that this Resolution would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid provision, sentence, clause or section had not been included herein.

RESOLVED and ADOPTED this 5th of June, 2026, by the Board of Directors of Jersey Shore Area Joint Water Authority, Lycoming County, Pennsylvania, at duly

advertised meeting of the Authority at which a quorum was present and intending to be legally bound hereby.
